

## FAQ on the use of the "e-methane" name and logo

Q	May other entities than city gas providers use the "e-methane" and the logo?
A	Yes. No special procedures are required to use them. Please use them in accordance with the "e-methane and Logo Usage" and the Logo Manual.
Q	When "e-methane" is used at the beginning of a sentence, should "e" be capitalized?
A	Please use "e".
Q	Is synthetic methane derived from blue/gray hydrogen also considered as "e-methane"?
A	<p>Yes. Synthetic methane produced by synthesizing hydrogen and CO<sub>2</sub> is called "e-methane".</p> <p>On the other hand, the following are not categorized as e-methane.</p> <p>*Examples of items not categorized as e-methane.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b>CO<sub>2</sub> credits offset greenhouse gases</b> generated in the process from <b>natural gas</b> extraction to combustion. ⇒Applies to carbon neutral LNG (carbon neutral city gas)</li> <li>● Artificial <b>crude oil</b> produced by synthesizing CO<sub>2</sub> and hydrogen ⇒Applies to e-fuel</li> </ul>
Q	What procedures are required when including the URL of a link to the e-methane referral site in materials?
A	No procedure is required to post the URL of the site or to link to it.
Q	Is it necessary to add "™" or "®" when using "e-methane" or the logo?
A	The addition of "™" or "®" is not necessary as we would like e-methane to be widely used.
